BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KINMUNDY, ILLINOIS:

Section 1:


Fishing Tournament Rules and Regulations

- a. Fishing Tournament or Contest Definitions. Any event at a City facility in which caught fish are scored, weighed, tabulated or calculated on site, and/or a prize of any kind (monetary, merchandise or recognized by plaque or trophy) is given to a person or persons, and use of the facility requires any arrangements above and beyond the normal function of the facility (tent construction, etc.) shall be considered a fishing contest or tournament. This is independent of whether a IDNR permit is required or not. All contests or tournaments held at any City facility shall abide by rules set by the Kinmundy City Council and ordinances of the City of Kinmundy.
- b. IDNR Permit. All individuals or groups wishing to hold a fishing tournament at a facility owned by the City of Kinmundy must receive a permit from the IDNR (if required by IDNR rules) and follow all IDNR regulations.
- c. City Approval: All individuals or groups wishing to hold a fishing tournament at a facility owned by the City of Kinmundy must receive approval from the Kinmundy City Council and submit required insurance and indemnification information ninety (90) days prior to the tournament.
- d. Boat Permit: All individuals participating in the tournament must purchase and display the required Boat Permit as specified in Ordinance #599 and Ordinance #534, An Ordinance establishing an annual Boat License and Fee, providing a penalty for putting a boat on the City Lakes without purchasing a Boat License.
- e. Contact Person: A responsible contact for the tournament must be identified to the City Council prior to the tournament ninety (30) days prior to the tournament. This individual will be responsible for enforcing the Boat Permit ordinance #599 and #534.
- f. Walk-through. Tournament officials are required to do a walk through of tournament activities with Kinmundy City Council or designee, a minimum of thirty (30) days prior to the tournament.


- g. Map of Tournament. A map or sketch of the layout of the tournament activities must be provided to the Kinmundy City Council thirty (30) prior to the tournament,
- h. Changes in Arrangements. Any changes from the map or pre-tournament arrangements must be cleared through the Kinmundy City Council prior to the start of the tournament during a regular monthly meeting.
- i. Parking. Parking and weigh-ins at no time shall hinder the public's use of the launch site.
- j. Restriction on Tournaments. No tournaments or contests shall be held on Memorial Day Weekend, July 4<sup>th</sup> Holiday and Labor Day weekend.
- k. City sites require that the tournament director or organizer either;
  - a. Provide proof of liability insurance of \$1,000,000; or
  - b. Require each individual who participates in the event to sign a liability waiver; obtained from the City office, prior to the event.
- l. Penalty. Any person or organization violating any provision of this ordinance shall be prohibited from scheduling future tournaments at City facilities.
